<p>99285: HX: comprehensive HPI – 4 elements required ROS – 10 systems required P, F, S HX – 2 required PE: comprehensive Exam – 8 systems required</p>	<p>Chief Complaint</p> <p>HPI – History of present illness Location – diffuse or localized, unilateral or bilateral, fixed or migratory Quality – sharp, dull, throbbing, stabbing, constant, intermediate</p>
<p>99284: HX: detailed HPI – 4 elements required ROS – 2 systems required P, F, S HX – 1 required PE: detailed Exam – 2-7 systems required</p>	<p>Severity – pain level Timing – nocturnal, continuous, repetitive pattern Duration – how long Context – cause Modifying factors – medications taking, what makes it worse or better Associated signs or symptoms</p>
<p>99283: HX: expanded problem focused HPI – 1 element required ROS – 1 system required PE: expanded problem focused Exam – 2-7 systems required</p>	<p>PMFS – Past medical, family and/or social history</p> <p>ROS – Review of systems Constitutional Eyes Ears, nose, throat (ENT)</p>

<p>99281: HX: problem focused HPI – 1 element required ROS – no requirement PE: problem focused Exam – 1 system required</p>	<p>Integumentary Neurological Psychiatric Endocrine Hematological/lymphatic Allergic/immunologic</p>
