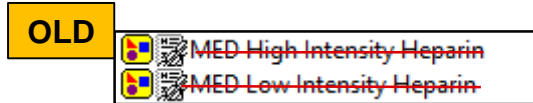


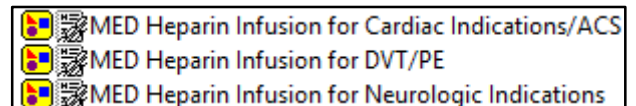
Rationale: To ensure patient safety, align with current best practice, and streamline provider workflow the heparin PowerPlans are renamed to clearly articulate indication and heparin doses are adjusted respectively.

New:

- ✓ The MED Low Intensity Heparin, MED High Intensity Heparin, and MED STEMI with Fibrinolytic Heparin PowerPlans are retired.



- ✓ The new PowerPlans are available for ordering:
 - **MED Heparin Infusion for Cardiac Indications/ACS**
 - **MED Heparin Infusion for DVT/PE**
 - **MED Heparin Infusion for Neurologic Indications**



- ✓ The heparin bolus orders are now separate from the infusion orders on the eMAR creating a separate item for review on the MAR Sum.
- ✓ In the following Heparin PowerPlans are additional PowerPlans within:
